


### **Transfer Characteristics**




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current







**Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage** 




 $T_J$  - Junction Temperature (°C) **On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature** 




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




**Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature**


