




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current






**Transfer Characteristics** 




Transconductance









On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature






Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature

**Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage** 









The part capabilities can widely vary depending on actual application parameters and operating conditions


